- 4- One of the following is mismatched ---> zygote 1n
- 5- When the morula reaches the uterine cavity ,, the endometrium is in the ---> secretory phase.
- 6- In meiosis 1 ---> separation of homologous chromosomes.
- 7- one of the following does not pass through popliteal fossa : anterior tibial artery
- 8- One of these is wrong regarding menstrual cycle ---> secretory phase is influenced by FSH
- 9- One of these gets out freely from the ovary during ovulation ---> cumulus oophorus.
